## ABOUT THE CHALLENGE

**The Marquette Challenge is a grassroots, student-led fundraising effort to advance the mission of the Foundation for Physical Therapy Research (FPTR).** Each year, hundreds of physical therapist (PT) and physical therapist assistant (PTA) students – with the support of program directors, faculty, and community – hold fundraising events across the U.S.

## STUDENTS GIVE FORWARD TO THEIR FUTURE PROFESSION

- The Challenge is critical to our ability to carry out the mission of the Foundation for Physical Therapy Research.
- Since 1989, more than 300 schools have participated, raising \$4.5 million for research.
- Funds raised through the Challenge provide funding for clinical researchers and support the rigorous scientific review process that sets FPTR apart in physical therapy research funding.

Faculty and students at Marquette University launched the first Challenge in 1989. Now, each year a cohost is selected based on the top fundraising school for the previous year's Challenge. Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) will cohost the 2021-2022 Marquette Challenge. Although there is a friendly competition between schools, the most important thing is participation at any level.
